WALLENPAUPACK AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT PURPLE AND WHITE CARD

Wallenpaupack Area School District proposes to offer **residents** of the school district, **62 years of age or older**, a Purple and White Card. Cardholders would be entitled to **free general admission** to any Wallenpaupack Area School District athletic event and most fine arts or other school district-sponsored activities, at the discretion of the event sponsor. The card only would be valid at events sponsored on school properties or facilities and cannot be used at play-off games.

The Wallenpaupack Area School District Board of Directors has established a program to honor World War II veterans who were forced to leave high school to serve their country. This program provides for the awarding of a Wallenpaupack High School Diploma to honorably discharged World War II veterans who did not graduate from a local high school. A diploma may be awarded posthumously to an eligible veteran through this program. Those eligible include honorably discharged veterans of United States military service in World War II between September 16, 1940 and December 31, 1946, and who attended any school that now comprise the current Wallenpaupack Area School District boundaries.



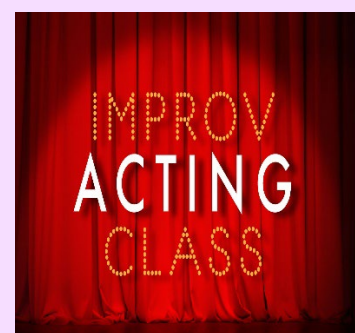

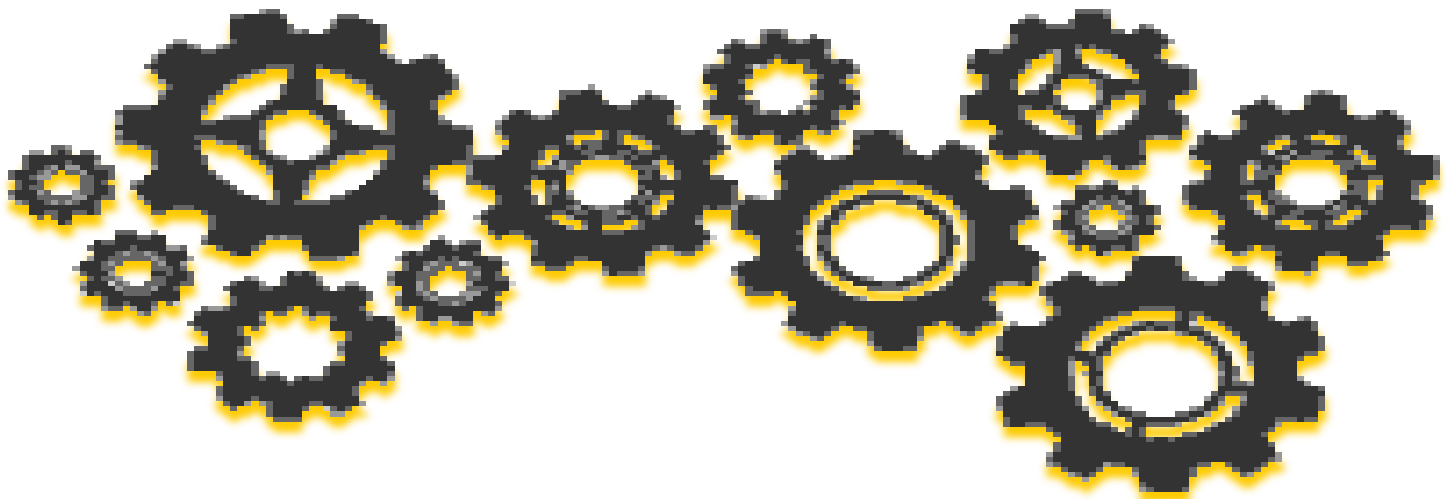
