Tuesday, June 18th

- "A" Day Final Exams for Blocks 1 and 2
- **Graduation practice** Seniors will eat "A" lunch. **Mandatory** graduation practice will begin at 11:45 am. Seniors must report to the gym for practice with their caps and gowns. The class photo will be taken during practice. Seniors will be allowed to leave school at the end of practice. January graduates must report to school by 11:00 am.
