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COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Concert Band and Symphonic Band represent the 2nd and 3rd levels of instruction of instrumental music. Concert Bank 7/8 and Symphonic Band are elective courses of study and are open to all qualified instrumental students in the seventh or eighth grades. Entrance into Symphonic Band is based on competitive auditions. Each 7th and 8th grade student is given one 45 minute lesson each week as part of a rotating schedule in order to develop individual skills necessary to perform competently on an instrument of choice. Each student meeting minimum skill levels continues to participate in full band ensembles that provide an outlet for the demonstration of instrumental skills and the experience of performing as a team of student musicians. Band students at this level perform in a Winter Concert, Spring Concert, school assemblies, and possibly two music festivals. Students not meeting minimal skill levels are assigned to classes designed to aid these students in attaining the required skills. Students are assessed and graded each quarter according to participation, organizational and performance skills.
