



# WALLENPAUPACK AREA HIGH SCHOOL

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Dear Wallenpaupack LIVE Students:

As we near the 2020-2021 school year, I wanted to share some information with you on expectations for the opening of school and beyond. As online learners, we want you to be engaged and interactive learners. Teachers will be using Schoology as the Learning Management System this year. You will be receiving grades in all of your classes and you must participate and complete assignments to receive attendance credit. This experience will be much different than what occurred in the spring and there will be more accountability for students participating from home. Please review these important reminders:

- On the first day of each class, you may access Schoology and look for your teacher's live conference. This will be a great opportunity to meet your teachers and learn about how they expect you to participate in their classes. Each teacher may do things differently, so this will be an important time to participate live and ask questions if you can.
- Please review the direction sheet titled, *Logging into Schoology and Clever on an iPad* to access your classes on Schoology.
- WAHS Dress Code must be followed by students participating from home.
- Teachers will communicate with students regarding the specific procedures to be followed for synchronous learning (real time) in each class. Students are encouraged to follow their daily schedule, block by block, including lunch. This may or may not include live instruction, but students can use this time to complete work for the designated block or ask their teacher questions.
- Students that choose asynchronous learning (at another time) will complete assignments on their own. Videos/lessons/assignments will be posted by teachers. Video recordings of classroom lessons may take time to upload so they might not be available the same day.
- Students that have a study hall do not need to do anything on Schoology; that is time they can work on their own.
- Students in grades 10-12 may notice their Academy and Pathway listed on their schedule; there is nothing that needs to be completed for these designations.
- Attendance will be based upon work completed and communication with the teacher. If students don't complete assignments, they may be marked absent for those days.
- Grades will be given to students.
- Cameras may or may not be used by students. Please follow the directions of your teachers in each of your classes for specific information.
- Guidance and Career Counselors are still available for you. Just email them directly or call the school to speak to them.
- Please review the Daily Bulletin in PowerSchool to read daily announcements and important information. The WAHS News Broadcast is also available on our website each day, beginning the second week of school.
