Students applying on-line through Common Application or Send Edu. , **please let your counselor know**. These sites often email your counselor, but these sometimes do not work as expected. Also, make sure you have your counselor's information correct when you put it in the computer.

Seniors wishing to have High School transcripts sent to colleges, technical schools, employers, etc. **MUST** pick up, complete and return two forms to the Guidance Office. One form is a Permission to Release Records form and the other is the Transcript Request form, which indicates where the transcript is to be sent.

Seniors absent from Senior Homeroom may pick up a copy of the Senior Guidance Bulletin in the Guidance Office or view it **online** under the Guidance Icon.
