Photo Information:

Professional photography will be available at the Prom. Bob Jennings Photo Shop will have two photo areas setup between 3 pm and 5 pm to lessen your wait in line. It is **strongly** encouraged that you get your pictures taken during this time. Photography will then continue after dinner until all couples and groups have been photographed. Your pictures must be paid in full prior to your photo session.

The Prom Package Rate is \$27.50, and will include the following:

Negatives from the event are permanently held on file, so re-orders can be provided at any time in the future.

The completed photographs will be delivered to the school for distribution within approximately 3 weeks.

Tuxedo Information:

Art's for Him in Honesdale has been made aware of our prom. A representative from Art's will come to the school during lunches to measure and take orders. You do not have to get measured/order then, you can go to their store in Honesdale to order as well. **Please note** – you can order your tuxedo from any retailer!!

Flower Information:

Corsages and boutonnieres **will not** be made available through our school; you must purchase them on your own.

WAHS Prom Rules

Guests

1. If you wish to bring a guest to the prom and the guest is not a WAHS student, a formal request must be submitted to Mrs. Nebzydoski or Miss Glynn for approval. ****Please note: Even if the guest is a graduate of WAHS or once attended WAHS, if he/she no longer attends the school he/she must complete a guest request.** (A completed Guest Request form must be submitted by the end of the day on Friday, April 29th.) **If a guest request for is not submitted and on file the guest will not be permitted to attend the Prom!!!!**
2. The WAHS student who is bringing the guest is responsible for the guest the entire evening.
3. No students enrolled in grade levels lower than 9th grade are allowed to attend the Prom.
4. Only one guest is allowed per student.
5. If you change guests you must tell Mrs. Nebzydoski or Miss Glynn so it can be recorded on the master list.
6. The guest must obey all school rules regardless of age.
7. The administration has at its discretion the right to refuse a guest from attending the Prom.
8. If you are not a senior or the date of a senior, you will not be allowed to attend the Prom.

Violation of Drug/Alcohol Policy

1. Penalties
 - a. You will be asked to leave immediately with no refund.
 - b. Your date may stay if he/she is a WAHS student.
 - c. Suspension – 10 days plus referral to administration and state police.
 - d. No Class Night.
 - e. No participation in any Senior Class spring activities.
2. Definition of “under the influence.”
 - a. You have the odor of alcohol/marijuana etc. on your breath.
 - b. Behavior attributable to being under the influence.
 - c. The chaperones find your behavior to be questionable in any way.

Leaving the Prom

1. Between dinner and the start of dancing in the nightclub, you may take cameras, sweaters, etc. to the car – chaperones will be in the parking lot at this time. **Do not go to your car without the permission of a chaperone!**
2. After that, if you leave the Prom, you may not return.
3. In an emergency, see a chaperone – he/she will go to the parking lot with you.

No Smoking – You and/or your guest may not smoke anywhere on Woodloch grounds.

Make sure that your attire is appropriate for the Prom – All school rules are in effect.

Monday after the Prom (5/2)

ALL students attending the Prom must be in school on Monday (5/2) by 11:10 for their 3rd block class. Students who arrive after 11:10 will receive 3 days of in school suspension. Senior students with early dismissal must be in school before 11:10 to sign in, and then they may leave.
