Summer School Information**

Courses are for students in grades 9 through 12 who have failed courses or who wish to improve their skills by auditing a course.

Course Fees

A fee of \$50.00 for each course is due at time of registration. A student may register for a maximum of two (2) courses. Checks are made payable to "WASD Community Education." **No Refunds will be made to students who withdraw from classes or who are suspended from the program for disciplinary reasons.**

Student Eligibility for Summer School Classes: If a student has failed a course with a minimum grade of 55% or obtained teacher approval the student is allowed to take the course for credit. Courses are weighted standard challenge for GPA purposes. Courses offered may be used to remediate failures in "C.P." and "Honors" classes at standard weight for G.P.A. purposes.

Grading: Students who pass summer school classes will receive a grade of 67 for the course.

Transporting students is often difficult for parents thus limiting the number of students that enroll in summer school. Therefore, the summer school curriculum will be delivered through an approved web-based provider. The on-line courses are aligned with WAHS curriculum and state standards.

All courses are internet based. Students will have the opportunity to access the courses on-line from home. All students are required to attend the first day of summer school, Mon. June 28th at 8:00am for training and placement testing. Students are welcome to attend any day for assistance from the teacher facilitator or for those who do not have internet access at home. Math students are **strongly encouraged** to attend on a regular basis due to the content of the curriculum. Hours are from 8:00am-12:00pm, Mon-Fri. Mid term & final exams, if required, must be taken on site.

Transportation: Students are responsible for their own transportation. Student parking will be available in designated areas only. Students will not be permitted in the parking lot or in their vehicles during class sessions. Cars should be locked, as Wallenpaupack Area School District cannot be responsible for personal belongings.

Discipline: All school policies as defined in the Wallenpaupack Area High School student handbook are in effect for the duration of summer school.
