 - Currently Wallenpaupack does not have any programs that fall under this category. If a program was to open in our district, we would follow all guidelines. As the host district, we would be responsible for the education of those students. Students who are residents of a 1306 program would be enrolled in the district in the same fashion as residents of the district. Student who are identified as special education students would be referred to the special education office. The current ER/RR and IEP would be reviewed by the director of special education and appropriate placement would be determined at an intake meeting. Determination for placement would be based on the record review and team input. The regular education environment would always be considered as the first placement option.
- 2. Describe the district's procedures for communicating with 1306 facilities and how the district ensures a successful transition back to school?

 The district would communicate regularly with the 1306 program staff to ensure enrollment procedures happened smoothly and in a timely fashion. When a student from a 1306 was enrolled in the district, every attempt would be made for the parents of the student to be contacted for participation in all meetings if appropriate. Communication would occur through email and phone and facility staff would be encouraged to contact the district with any concerns.

1. Describe the system of oversight the District would implement to ensure that all incarcerated students who may be eligible for special education are located, identified, evaluated and when deemed eligible, are offered a free appropriate public education (FAPE).

The School District provides a part-time teacher at the Pike County Correctional Facility. An itinerant special education teacher is assigned to the program to instruct any student with an IEP. We follow Chapter 14 regulations in locating, identifying, evaluating, and offering FAPE to eligible students. The Director of Special Education directly supervises this program. As part of the intake process eligible individuals are given a form by the teacher to complete upon arrival at the Correctional Facility. We secure records on each inmate from the Corrections Education Records Center. Child Find information is posted at the correctional facility. Evaluations are performed and IEPs are developed according to all Chapter 14 regulations.

Least Restrictive Environment

- 1. Review the district's data for Least Restrictive Environment. Highlight areas of improvement.

 Our current reported data from the 2019/2020 school year is as follows: Inside the regular education classroom 80% or more: 72.9% (State Average: 61.5%)

 Inside the regular education classroom less than 40%: 7.0% (State Average: 9.6%) Special Education in other settings: 2.5% (State Average: 4.8%)

 Currently the district has no areas that require improvement.
- 2. What universal practices does the district utilize to address the academic and social/emotional needs of all students in need of accommodations to their learning environments?
 - We operate under the principle of Least Restrictive Environment to meet students' needs. All of our students are integrated to the highest extent possible. Regular education teachers receive professional development on differentiating instruction and accommodating/modifying work for students. Students are supported in regular education classes by utilizing the co-teach model in the ELA and math classrooms. Students may also be supported by using Paraeducators and Personal Care Assistants, all who are highly qualified. The district social workers work with regular education teachers to support the behavioral/emotional issues of our students in the classroom. The districts works cooperatively with service providers that provide BHT, Behavioral Support, Mobile Therapy, Family Therapy, and Case Management to our students so that they can receive the support they need to be included.
- 3. Describe the academic programming and training efforts the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in the general education curriculum.
 - We have an active Act 48 committee with representation from special and regular education teachers, administrators, and specialists. This committee completes needs assessments and recommends training as needed in the district. Professional Learning Communities have been established for consistent and ongoing professional development. The training is delivered in a variety of ways, including targeted training for specific needs and ongoing training in district initiatives. We utilize a variety of sources for training including PaTTAN, Intermediate Unit, conferences, webinars, and trainers and consultants at the district. The co-teach model is supported throughout the district with professional development and common planning periods. Regular education teachers receive regular professional development on differentiating instruction and providing accommodations/modifications for students with special needs.
- 4. Describe the supplementary aids and services the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in extracurricular activities. When developing IEPs, the team considers extra-curricular activities for students when looking at supplemental aids and services. Personal care assistants, interpreters, specialized transportation, and access to assistive technology have all been used to help include special education students in extra curricular activities. In addition, the district is committed to providing unique opportunities for our students with special needs to participate in extra curricular activities. At the elementary and middle schools, we have a Unified Cub and we conduct Unified Intramural Bocce. This is done through Special Olympics and incorporates regular and special education students. At the high school, we have PIAA Unified Bocce and Track teams. We also have a Unified Club that plans district wide inclusion events such as Inclusion Week, Polar Pop, and the Rain Rally.
- 5. Describe the District procedures, which ensure that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities placed in private institutions are educated with non-disabled children and have the opportunity to participate in district lead extracurricular activities?

 The school district offers a full continuum of programs and levels of intervention for students with disabilities. Programs include Learning Support, Life Skills Support, Multiple Disabilities Support, Emotional Support, Autistic Support, Hearing Impaired Support, Blind/Visually Impaired Support, Physical Support, and Speech and Language Support. With this variety of programs, we are able to serve the needs of the majority of students within their home district. Levels of intervention range from itinerant intervention within the regular classroom to full-time support programs. Program decisions are made by the IEP

team with the parent playing a major role. The school district is part of a consortium with two neighboring school districts. Through this consortium we are able to meet the needs of our low-incidence population students and provide the following services: Life Skills Support, Multiple Disabilities Support, Autistic Support, Emotional Support, Intensive Emotional Support, Social Work, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Hearing and Vision. We have a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) on staff who works with students at risk for a more restrictive setting and their families. This process has been very successful in maintaining students with challenging behavior in the regular school setting. When a student's needs cannot be met within the district or consortium we utilize center-based programs provided by the Intermediate Unit and /or private providers. When this occurs we work closely with the family to secure their input in the process. It is important for the family to know that even though the student is placed outside the district they are still our student. We participate in all IEP and progress monitoring meetings. We ensure that the students are able to participate in extra-curricular and athletic activities and develop plans to transition the students back to the district.

- 6. Discuss the district's need to build capacity and expand programs and services in an effort to provide a continuum of services. (Consider the out of district placement chart)
 - At this time, the district has programs offering a continuum of services to support a high percentage of students. The district also partners with two neighboring districts in a Consortium to share low incidence classrooms. These Consortium classrooms are offered in typical school buildings so that inclusion can happen to the maximum extent possible for each student. There is no need to build additional capacity at this time.

- 1. How does the district support the emotional, social needs of students with disabilities?
 - The District employs three Social Workers and a Social Work Assistant to work with our students. They perform FBAs and develop PBSPs for their students. They provide counseling and instruction in areas of need exhibited by the students to help in their successful integration in the buildings. They also provide ongoing support and training to parents. The District also employs 15 school counselors who also serve our students in identifying social and emotional needs. They provide counseling and instruction in areas of need along with support for parents. The District also employs a Diversity, Equality, and Inclusion (DEI) counselor who works to identify student needs in the school and community setting while facilitating trainings for students and staff. All professional staff have received training in trauma-informed classrooms. The District participates in the Schools and Homes in Education (SHINE) after school program. This program provides additional social and emotional supports while also providing educational opportunities for our students. The District also runs an evidence-based family skills training program for high-risk and general population families called Strengthening Families which is recognized both nationally and internationally. This program works with parents and youth who take skills classes together, learning parenting skills and youth life and refusal skills.
- 2. Describe training provided to staff in the use of positive behavior supports, de-escalation techniques and responses to behavior that may require immediate intervention.
 - The Superintendent or designee shall provide regular training, and retraining as needed, of staff in the use of specific procedures, methods and techniques, including de-escalation, and restraints and seclusion, that will be used to implement positive behavior supports or intervention in accordance with students' IEPs and Board policy. The District utilizes a school counselor who is certified as a trainer in Therapeutic Agression Control Techniques (TACT 2). He provides ongoing TACT 2 training to staff, including trauma-sensitive behavior management, crisis de-escalation, and physical intervention. The District also has a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) on staff who provides training on Positive Behavior Interventions, Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA), and Positive Behavior Support Plans (PBSP). She also performs FBAs, writes PBSPs, and works with parents on positive behavior interventions within the home.
- 3. Describe the district positive school wide support programs.
 - We participate in training offered by PaTTAN in the area of positive behavior support, classroom management, and de-escalation. The elementary and intermediate school utilizes a PBIS model. The district is currently researching programming and will implement a district positive school wide support program.
- 4. Describe the district school-based behavior health services.
 - Wallenpaupack collaborates with Friendship House in providing a School Based Mental Health Clinic and School Based Tele-Psychiatry. We also contract with Friendship House to provide a full-time licensed therapist in our schools. We provide a location in our buildings for these services so that our families do not have to travel or miss school. The district also works closely with various service providers who provide Behavioral Health Services within the district.

The District makes referrals to these providers when needs arise and supports families in implementing outside services. BHT, Behavior Consultation, Mobile Therapy, Family Therapy, and case management all occur within our schools. These services are represented in each buildings Student Assistance Teams as needed. The South Elementary school houses a Behavioral Health Team provided by Friendship House who works with students during the school day.

5. Describe the district restraint procedure.

Each building has a crisis response team who is trained to respond when needed. Restraints to control acute or episodic aggressive behavior may be used only when the student is acting in a manner that presents a clear and present danger to the student, other students or employees, and only when less restrictive measures and techniques have proven to be or are less effective. Per District policy, the Director of Special Education or designee shall notify the parent/guardian as soon as practicable of the use of restraints to control the aggressive behavior of the student and shall convene a meeting of the IEP team within ten (10) school days of the use of restraints, unless the parent/guardian, after written notice, agrees in writing to waive the meeting. At this meeting, the IEP team shall consider whether the student needs a functional behavioral assessment, re-evaluation, a new or revised Positive Behavior Support Plan, or a change of placement to address the inappropriate behavior.

- There are a full range of services, programs and alternative placements available to the school district for placement and implementation of the special education programs in the school district.
