The Board appointed teacher Stephen Peters as the Head Coach of the newly formed Girls' Wrestling program. He will be joined by volunteer coach Elana Carroll. This is the first sanctioned season for Girls' Wrestling in the state of Pennsylvania and Wallenpaupack intends to have a team with roughly thirty participants.
